

Sunrise Community Counseling Center
has been awarded two multi-year grants totaling \$2.3 million
from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services,
Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA).

This funding will support the following programs:

- **Family-Centered Substance Abuse Treatment for Latino youth (age 12-17)**
 - Services for youth experiencing substance use issues and/or co-occurring substance use and mental health disorders
 - Supporting positive change through enhancing interaction between youth, their family and their environment.
 - Pro-social activities including the Sunrise Crew Youth sailing program

- **Family-Centered Substance Abuse and HIV Prevention for Latina Women with Children**
 - Latina mothers (all ages) and their children will have access to no-cost family counseling and case management.
 - No-cost HIV testing and counseling
 - Community health literacy leadership intervention
 - Stress reduction and physical fitness

Programs use evidence-based models that are family inclusive and culturally and linguistically appropriate. Case management and wrap-around services always support a system of care.

Services are provided free of charge to eligible participants.
